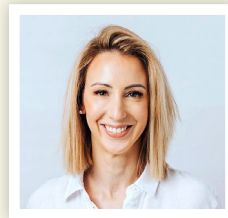

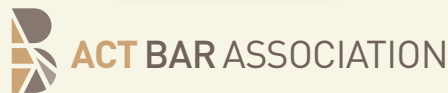

There is a higher than average level of stress within the legal profession. This may take the form of anxiety, depression, alcohol and drug misuse, family issues, work pressures, perfectionism and self-criticism, not to mention the lack of sleep.
